## Muskoka fireplaces & stoves are CARB Certified

In 2007, The California Air Resources Board (CARB) approved an airborne toxic control measure (ATCM) to reduce formaldehyde emissions from composite wood products, including hardwood plywood, medium density fiberboard and particleboard. The ATCM applies to all manufacturers, distributors, importers, fabricators, retailers and third party certifiers of composite wood products and finished goods which are destined for the California market.

Formaldehyde, used commonly in the process of manufacturing wood composites, has both cancer and non-cancer health effects and has been linked to the increase of asthma. Related cancer risk in adults and children is estimated to be reduced by 40% as a result of the ACTM.

Greenway Home Products agrees that everyone, including the general public, must be able to determine quickly and easily that the goods they are purchasing are low in formaldehyde emissions and comply with the ATCM.

The CARB-certified symbol is prominently displayed on all Muskoka® packaging to indicate that our merchandise has been certified to these strict standards.
